2022 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Eligibility: Eligibility is limited to law students who are currently enrolled at an accredited law school in full-time or part-time programs at the time of application and award. Preference will be given to candidates who are or intend to become active members of their APALSA or APABA; and those who intend to practice law in the South Florida area and become active members of APABA South Florida. Scholarship applicant finalists will participate in a virtual interview session as part of the application process. One scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00 may be awarded each calendar year. The scholarship recipient must present a five-minute overview (either in-person or by Zoom) about the work the scholarship enabled the recipient to do at the annual APABA South Florida installation gala in the fall.

<u>Application and Attachments:</u> Please provide truthful and detailed answers to the application questions and in the required attachments. APABA South Florida will maintain all information received from and about applicants in confidence.

<u>Selection Criteria:</u> In addition to the applicant's answers to the application questions and the requested documentation, APABA South Florida will consider financial need, community service, academic achievement, and purpose for which the scholarship is sought.
